

## **Announcement of Satun Province on the Policy of Integrity and Transparency in Work Operations**


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According to the wills of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (B.E.2560), the Official Information Act (B.E.2540), the Royal Decree on Principals and Implementing Good Governance (B.E. 2546), Phase 3 of the National Anti-Corruption Strategy (B.E.2560-2564), and the Government Policy (no.10) "Promoting Administration of State to Uphold Good Governance and Preventing and Suppressing Corruption and Malfeasance in the Public Sector", these documents aim to implant values, norms, and a moral conscience in the minds of government officials to encourage them to perform their duties with honour and in a corruption-free manner. These documents ensure effective public administration to prevent and suppress all corruption or illegal acts of governmental officials at all levels, and to respond to public demands and facilitate people in order to strengthen bureaucratic credentials.

Therefore, Satun Province has prescribed the policy of morality and transparency to prevent corruption as a standard to be regulated and to be valued for government officials and all government employees in order that they abide by rules and regulations and other terms. The aim of this policy is to lead organizations to carry out the mission with transparency and to manage with honesty and integrity. In order to achieve this policy, Satun prescribes guidelines for government officers, government agencies, all district offices, and all sub-district offices in Satun Province to be abided by strictly as follows:

1. Administrate and abide by good governance principles to meet the needs of the people with a fast, accurate, equitable, transparent and fair service.
2. Set values and attitudes to personnel in the organization to have knowledge, understanding, ethics, morality and apply the philosophy of sufficiency economy for use in the work and way of life.
3. Procure and promote the transparent implementation at all levels and also open the opportunity for the private sector, civil society, and the public sector in monitoring the operation by publicising the implementation information in all activities to them.
4. Persuade people to report to Satun Damrongtham Center when finding evidence of fraud.
5. In cases of corruption, officers will be investigated and severely punished if found guilty.
